- *Affiliations*
 - o Club versus 19 Player systems.
 - o Most associations have declared themselves Clubs (See D4 web site about affiliations).
 - o Within the Club system, coaches are asked to share the affiliation around the teams giving many players the opportunity to play up.
 - o Refer to interpretation email from District 4, Chair.
- *Fighting Rule*
 - o Most problems at Midget with Bantam a close second.
 - o Bottom line if suspended by ODMHA rules then the LCMHL will add an equal amount onto the suspension.
 - o Note meaningful games are defined as league or tournament games (not exhibition games).
- *Player Suspended*
 - o Coaches check with your President or LCMHL representative.

- A Coach who plays a suspended player is automatically suspended for 5 games.
- *Game Rescheduling / Swapping*
 - A maximum of THREE (3) for the entire season. The count for this activity goes to the requesting team.
 - Must have game rescheduled before the original date to be played.
 - Inform your Statistician, Officials, and other that your association requires you to notify.
 - Statements like “no goalie”; “in a tournament”; “not enough players” are not acceptable, especially with the CLUB system.
 - Weather and change required by the association ice schedulers are exceptions.
- *Season*
 - October 12, 2007 to February 18, 2008
- *Playoff Format*
 - Going back to the format from a couple of years ago as defined in LCMHL Regulation # 17.

- Divisions with more than 13 teams have been divided in two divisions, one called RedLine and the other BlueLine and the teams evenly split between the two.
- Game Sheet minimum items to include:
 - LCMHL Game Number.
 - Division – include BlueLine / RedLine.
 - LCMHL Team Name (the one on the LCMHL schedule).
 - Suspensions – must be initialled by the referee.
 - Infractions – use codes on back of game sheet.
- Running clock
 - 50 minutes for 1 hr games
 - 80 minutes for 1.5 hr games
